

COUNCIL'S FORWARD PLAN

1. To work with the town's traders to encourage additional footfall within the town centre. This will be facilitated by the appointment of a new post of Town Centre Coordinator by the Town Council
2. To work in partnership with MDDC to ensure that the new town centre CCTV system operates as effectively and efficiently as possible
3. To examine the possibility of the town council investing in a community centre to be cited on the new Eastern Urban Extension development of the town
4. To further develop facilities for people with mobility issues to be able to rent an allotment plot within the council's allotment garden sites
5. To further utilise the facilities of the Community Boat which operates on the Grand Western Canal
6. To examine the feasibility of the town council taking over the two principle parks within the town.
7. To work with Devon County Council Definitive Map Review Team to update the parish definitive map. This will involve consultation with the general public.
8. To liaise with the Tiverton Neighbourhood Plan team to ensure that when the plan becomes a legal document processes are in place to ensure that applicable planning applications are in line with the plan
9. To cooperate with the Tiverton Leat Charitable Trust to ensure the restoration and upkeep of the heritage asset.
10. To work in association with major stake holders like Great Western Railways and Stagecoach to improve the bus link between Tiverton Parkway Train Station and the Tiverton Town Centre
11. To work in association with Devon County Council and Bickleigh Parish Council to provide a foot /cycle way between the two parishes using, where possible the rout of the former Exe Valley railway. To further push for the extension of this route towards Exeter
12. To work with MDDC and Dorset County Council to improve the cycle and footway provision within the parish
13. To work towards Tiverton becoming a dementia friendly town
14. To work towards Tiverton becoming more sustainable and helping to save the planet.
