01	Election of Chairman
	Cllr A Hendy was elected as chairman.
02	Apologies

03	Confirmation of Committee

04	Community Energy Group
	Cllr S Bush provided the group with some background on this project. The
	original intention was to have three energy sites, being in Tiverton, Hele and
	Thorverton. There would appear to be some financial problems in setting the
	sites up and it was unclear where MDDC stood on the progress of this scheme. Chris Shers was the lead officer for this project. Agreed that the
	town clerk would contact Chris to discuss this and to see if he would attend
	the next meeting. Cllr S Bush would forward information to all members of
	the group. It might also be possible for someone to talk to us about setting
	up a community energy company.
05	Tree Planting
	Cllr B Holman stated that MDDC had set up a working party to look at a
	number of issues including tree planting. He would explore whether MDDC
	would be interested in working with the town council on this project. Mrs
	Pelaou stated that Heathcoat Fabrics might be willing to provide some
	funding for tree planting. Agreed that councillors would be asked to provide suitable locations for tree planting within their wards.

06	MD Climate Change Policy Working Group
	Cllr B Holman agreed to ask this working party if they would be willing to
	allow a representative of this committee to join their working party. It was

	generally felt that the best idea would be for different members of this committee to have the opportunity of attending that working group depending on the topic under discussion.
	Cllr A Perris made mention of the People's Assembly Action Plan and felt that some aspects cold be used by this committee. Some of these items include car sharing and pooling, recycling points and public information points. Other items included reducing plastic usage by supermarkets, with possible collection points in the town for items that are not at present dealt with under the MDDC recycling scheme. Agreed that further discussions would take place on this subject at the next meeting.
